

## OLD MAGNESIA WELL PUMP ROOM RESTORATION PROJECT




The Old Magnesia Well

With your help we aim to restore this building which helped to put Harrogate on the map more than 150 years ago and contributes enormously to the story of how Harrogate became the town that it is today.



Our fund-raising efforts today will contribute towards the restoration of this important historical building.

Built in 1858, the Old Magnesia Well Pump Room served as a dispensary for the spring water rising from the nearby Magnesia Well. Demand for the water became so great by the 1890s that a larger building was required to cater for the number of fashionable visitors taking the waters. The New Magnesia Well Pump Room came into service around the turn of the century. That building is now a café within the park.

The Old Magnesia Well Pump Room was used as Harrogate Corporation's Museum at the turn of the 20th Century before it was closed to the public and fell into disrepair.






