Burnby Hall Gardens

o matter where you are in Yorkshire, you won't be far from one of the lovely gardens that are open to the public. A few have a history stretching back centuries, others have only recently been created.

Valley Gardens in Harrogate are only a mile away from the Royal Horticultural Society's Harlow Carr Gardens. However, unlike Harlow Carr they cost nothing to visit. In addition to plants, you get a bonus in this garden - more mineral springs surface here than anywhere else in the world. In fact, part of Valley Gardens is known as Bogs Field because almost half of Harrogate's mineral wells are there and the gardens were voted the country's Best Public Park in the 2009 'Britain in Bloom' competition.

The circular flower beds, some with decorated well heads in the middle, were put in this English Heritage Grade II Listed garden in the 1920s. About a decade before that, one very determined city father, Alderman Binns, was so adamant that the park's boundary should be extended, he rolled his sleeves up and, under cover of darkness, personally knocked down the dividing wall.

Staying in North Yorkshire, Parcevall Hall Gardens were the home of the late Sir William Milner, an admirer of Arts and Crafts gardeners such as Gertrude Jekyll.
